Lunch Monitor essential duties:

- Guides students safely from classroom to playground
- Monitor behavior of children at lunch and recess
- Aid students in lower grades with winter apparel (zipping coats, etc)
- Maintain order in classroom during indoor recess
- Walk children quietly and orderly from cafeteria to school after lunch
- Render minor first aid treatment as needed (scraped knee, etc)

All adults working with young people in AOD schools must take the Protecting God's Children class and pass a background check
