

Tuition Assistance Information

Archdiocese of Detroit

The Archdiocese of Detroit offers tuition assistance through the Stewards of Tomorrow Campaign. ***There is a new process for applying for this grant.*** There are now 2 rounds that your application can fall into. Please read all instructions completely and ahead to the deadlines for the on line applications. The awards for the school year are as follows: Tier 1 = \$1100.00, Tier 2 = \$950.00 and Tier 3 = \$800.00. Applications are available for all Catholic families either on the parish web site www.cabriniparish.org or on the Archdiocese website at www.aod.org. Applications can only be completed on line. Instructions are in the application. There is a \$30.00 on-line application fee. Please follow the payment instructions indicated on the application.

Father Clare Murphy Scholarship Fund (for registered parishioners of Cabrini)

This scholarship fund was established by Father Clare Murphy to assist St. Frances Cabrini Parish families who have financial need. Applicants must be ***registered St. Frances Cabrini families*** and have financial need. Applications are available at the Parish Office or on the schools web site. **Applications are to be returned by March 16th to the Parish Office.** You will be notified by April 30th of the amount that will be awarded.

• Cabrini Tuition fund (for non-registered parishioners)

This scholarship was created to be able to offer financial help to families that are not registered at Cabrini. Applicants must show a financial need. Applications are available at the Parish Office or on the schools web site. **Applications are to be returned by March 16th to the Parish Office.** You will be notified by April 30th of the amount that will be awarded.

Education for a Brighter Future (for elementary students only)

This Scholarship is available to children residing in Wayne County and entering Kindergarten or transferring into grades 1 through 5 in the 2018-19 school year. This award is done by a random drawing, once qualified you will receive assistance up through grade 8 as long as the income guidelines have been met each year. Applications are available by calling (313) 883-8570.

Application deadline is April 1st.

Dear Cabrini School Parent,

It is hard to believe that we are almost through the first month of 2018 and that preparations are under way for the 2018-2019 school year! These preparations include analysis of our financial plan and budget for the coming year by the parish / school staff and various councils and making appropriate changes where necessary. It is clearly understood that the families who make the commitment for their children to receive a Cabrini education are making sacrifices to do so. We also understand that for many, fulfilling the financial commitment that is required can only be met with some form of financial aid or assistance. As a result, this letter is to inform you that going forward, a new policy has been established by our Tuition Review Committee covering all school tuition matters.

This new policy establishes the following:

- Tuition assistance will be offered, as available, in the form of grants provided by St. Frances Cabrini Parish, the Archdiocese of Detroit or other sponsoring organizations. Any new request for assistance or relief will be overseen, exclusively, by the Cabrini Scholarship Committee. **The Pastor and Bookkeeper/Tuition Office will no longer accept appointments for discussion of tuition assistance.**

If you would like to request financial assistance, please do the following:

- a. For new school families: complete the on-line FACTS registration, found at cabriniparish.org. For returning school families, you are already re-enrolled. If changes are needed, contact the Tuition Office, otherwise no further action needed. The use of the FACTS tuition system is required of all Cabrini School families, as stated in the registration information.
- b. Complete the attached Cabrini Scholarship Aid Form. All assistance coming from the parish, will come from either the Fr. Clare Murphy or Cabrini Scholarship Funds.
- c. Apply for the Archdiocese of Detroit Tuition School Grant. There will now be a 3 tier system for this Grant: \$1100, \$950, and \$800. It will be solely based on need and is not dependent on whether a student is in high school or elementary.

***Both (a) and (b) need to be accomplished by March 16, 2018.** The Scholarship Aid Form is in the parish office or online at the schools web site. The AOD School Grant (c) is available at aod.org or cabriniparish.org.

Clarification for tuition assistance that is being offered for Cabrini parents through the parish:

- a. Given the limited funds at our disposal, assistance will be based solely on need. Every effort will be made to help as many families as possible, but there is no guarantee that all applicants will receive assistance or be granted the full amount they are requesting.
- b. The amount being awarded for each family from the parish (*Fr. Clare Murphy or Cabrini Scholarship Funds*) will be announced by April 30, 2018.
- c. The AOD Tuition Grant is awarded according to the schedule of the Archdiocese of Detroit, and not overseen by the parish. The first tier awards will be announced in May.

Other considerations available for tuition assistance:

- a. If you are a registered member at a parish other than St. Frances Cabrini, please follow these steps:
 1. Have your pastor send a letter stating you are an active member. *This will provide you the more affordable, Catholic rate tuition.*
 2. Consider asking your pastor if your parish has any tuition assistance funds.
- b. If you are an employee of the Archdiocese of Detroit or St. Frances Cabrini, this qualifies you for a tuition discount. Please contact the Cabrini Tuition Office for more details if you qualify. (313-381-5601)

I appreciate the great sacrifice all of you make to send your child(ren) to a Catholic school. Please be assured that we are doing everything possible to honor that sacrifice and deserve your trust.
