Sweetest Heart of Mary Church - When Polish immigrants came to America back in the late 1800s and early 1900s, they found comfort and community in their churches. Sweetest Heart of Mary Church was a cornerstone of the Polish community in Detroit. It remains a source of pride and a beacon of faith for Polish Americans in the metro Detroit area to this day. With a long tradition of celebrating Polish customs, "Hearts" as it is affectionately referred to, still connects its parishioners with the homeland of their ancestors.

Traffic Jam & Snug (included lunch) - Known for their in-house bakery, microbrewery, and dairy. Choose between Madras Meatloaf, Londontown Fish & Chips, Vegetarian Spinach Lasagna, Chicken Pot Pie or Pot Roast. All served with salad, bread, beverage and homemade cookie from their bakery.

St. Joseph's Church - Docent-led tour takes us inside this awe-inspiring church founded to accommodate Detroit's growing German population. Built in 1870, it was the largest church in the city at the time. Designed by German-born architect Francis G. Himpler, St. Joseph's Church seems transplanted from Germany. It's rich in architectural details such as carved wood ornamentation, stained glass windows by world-famous glassmakers Mayer of Munich, and what's reputed to be the largest swinging bell in the entire United States

St. Anne de Detroit Catholic Church - Spanning the trajectory covering three centuries, Ste. Anne reigns as the second oldest parish in the country with an unbroken history. Its twin spires studded with stunning stained glass rise from a southwest Detroit neighborhood tucked under the Ambassador Bridge.
