

International Student Application Procedure

Step 1

A student, family or guardian must apply for admission in writing to Cabrini High School. The student will need to fill out the Cabrini High School application located on the Cabrini Parish website. The acceptance will be according to Cabrini's admissions policies, as well as the Archdiocese of Detroit policies.

Along with the initial admission criteria, the school will also review the following: English language proficiency, valid academic transcripts (past 3 years and translated in English). Financial stability (i.e. bank statements or pay stubs which will need to be submitted every school year. Proof of all immunizations have been given, Current Passport, and Current Visa. Contact Private and Public School Exchange (pse-edu.org to help with application and placement of student with a host family.

Please note: It is the family or guardian's responsibility to provide all the proper documentation for the school to review.

ALL APPLICATION MATERIALS ARE DUE BY APRIL 19, 2019

Step 2

Once the student has demonstrated English proficiency through a Skype Interview, passed either the Toefl or Eltis test, provided academic transcripts which will be reviewed by our Counselor and a clean disciplinary record, Cabrini High School will provide a letter of acceptance.

Step 3

Upon acceptance, Cabrini High School will request an I-20 form from the Archdiocese of Detroit's Office of Catholic Schools. The potential student will then be entered in the SEVIS immigration database. This form will be needed for the student's US Consulate/Embassy visa appointment.

Please note: Before going to the US Embassy, the student/family must pay a government fee, called the SEVIS I-901 fee

Before the I-20 form is delivered to the student/family, a tuition contract must be signed and on file at Cabrini High School

Current Tuition Rate: \$10,050 – This includes a \$100 non-refundable Deposit
