



DRESS CODE 2019-2020

Schoolbelles is the source for our school uniforms. Below are the **dress code requirements** for the 2019-2020 school year.

FRESHMEN BOYS INCOMING CLASS OF 2023

**** The following items MUST be purchased from Schoolbelles: Polo, tie, pants, shorts. Socks, belt, long sleeve white dress shirt, and shoes may be purchased from a department store/store of choice. Gym clothes must be purchased through Ms. Shro and available during bookstore sale in August.**



- **Shirt:** CHS Navy Polo to be tucked into CHS pants
- **Mass Days ONLY-** White long sleeve button down dress shirt with Cabrini Tie purchased from Schoolbelles. Although this is required on Mass days, it is optional for other school days.



- **Pants:** CHS khaki pants from Schoolbelles must be worn. Pants must be worn at the waist with a brown/black belt properly secured.

● **Shorts:** CHS Schoolbelles shorts are optional to wear during designated dates. Athletic shoes may be worn with shorts during designated dates.

● **Shoes:** Dress Shoes that are all black, brown, tan or blue solid colored leather or the like, sturdy lace up shoes that come to the top of the middle of the foot with a heel no higher than one inch are acceptable.



- **Socks:** Navy or white socks must be worn at all times and must be visible.
- **Pullovers/Sweaters (optional):** CHS sweaters, CHS quarter zips, or designated CHS athletic pullover can be worn as an **option** over CHS polo. **These now can only be bought through Schoolbelles.** No hooded sweatshirts are permitted.



FRESHMEN GIRLS INCOMING CLASS OF 2023

**** The following items MUST be purchased from Schoolbelles: Polo, skirt/skort. Socks and shoes may be purchased from a department store/store of choice. Gym clothes must be purchased through Ms. Shro and available during bookstore sale in August.**



- **Shirt:** CHS Navy Polo tucked into skirt/skort
- **Skirt/Skort:** Choice of skirt or skort in designated pattern must be worn. CHS pants can also be worn. Picture shown above.
- **Shoes:** Dress Shoes that are all black, brown, tan or blue solid colored leather or the like, sturdy lace up shoes that come to the top of the middle of the foot with a heel no higher than one inch are acceptable. Most girls purchase Sperry's or a similar type of shoe.
- **Socks:** Navy or white socks must be worn at all times and must be visible.
- **Pullovers/Sweaters (optional):** CHS sweaters, CHS quarter zips, or designated CHS athletic pullover can be worn as an **option** over CHS polo. **These now can only be purchased through Schoolbelles.** No hooded sweatshirts are permitted.

CABRINI BOYS

- **Shirt:** CHS Navy/white Polo to be tucked into CHS pants (can have old logo)
- **Mass Days ONLY-** Blue/White long sleeve **button down dress shirt with tie**. *Boys have option to purchase new CHS tie. Although this is only required on Mass days, it is **OPTIONAL** for other days of the week.*
- **Pants:** CHS khaki pants from Schoolbelles must be worn. Pants must be worn at the waist with a brown/black belt properly secured.
- **Shorts:** CHS Schoolbelles shorts are optional to wear during designated dates. Athletic shoes may be worn only with shorts during designated dates.
- **(UPDATED RULE) Socks:** Navy or white socks must be worn at all times and must be visible.
- **Shoes:** Dress Shoes that are all black, brown, tan or blue solid colored leather or the like, sturdy lace up shoes that come to the top of the middle of the foot with a heel no higher than one inch are acceptable.
- **Pullovers/Sweaters (optional):** CHS sweaters, CHS quarter zips, or designated CHS athletic pullover can be worn as an **option** over CHS polo/button down shirt with tie. **These now can only be purchased through Schoolbelles.** Can have the old logo. No hooded sweatshirts are permitted.

CABRINI GIRLS

- **Shirt:** CHS Navy/white Polo tucked into skirt (can have old logo)
- **Skort:** Green/blue skort with shorts underneath (can purchase new freshmen skirt with new pattern) Athletic shoes may be worn with skirts during designated dates.
- **Shorts:** CHS Schoolbelles shorts are optional to wear during designated warm period. Athletic shoes may be worn with shorts during designated dates.
- **Pants:** CHS pants can be worn
- **(UPDATED RULE) Socks:** Navy or white socks must be worn at all times and must be visible.
- **Shoes:** Dress Shoes that are all black, brown, tan or blue solid colored leather or the like, sturdy lace up shoes that come to the top of the middle of the foot with a heel no higher than one inch are acceptable.
- **Pullovers/Sweaters (optional):** CHS sweaters, CHS quarter zips, or designated CHS athletic pullover can be worn as an **option** over CHS polo. **These now can only be purchased through Schoolbelles.** Can have the old logo. No hooded sweatshirts are permitted.

The 2019-2020 school year is upon us! This school year we have updated our school dress code to make a more unified and modern look. We surveyed multiple school stakeholders before considering any developments to the uniform. The updated Cabrini High School uniform wear is **only a requirement for the incoming freshmen class of 2023**. Their new requirements are listed under the Freshmen Class of 2023 heading.

For all current sophomores, juniors, and seniors, there is **no need** to purchase new Cabrini uniform wear. We are grandfathering in our former uniform wear for these students. If a current sophomore, junior, or senior choose to purchase the new skirt/skort, polo, pullover that is their choice. Students can buy new items and wear with the old uniform clothes if they choose to do so as well. However, we have updated a few uniform rules for boys and girls. The updated rules are listed with the uniform requirements and must be followed by all students.

This year, Cabrini has a special "Store Ordering Night" for our school. Schoolbelles store is offering exclusive specials for Cabrini students and families. The ordering night will occur at the Schoolbelles store located in Canton: **42073 Ford Rd, on May 31st from 4-6 pm**. Although not mandatory, we strongly encourage you to come to the store and try on uniforms to ensure proper fit and place your orders. We want to make sure your student receives their order and are in full uniform on the 1st full of day of school.

General Rules:

- CHS Shorts/skirt/skort and tennis shoes may be worn during the designated dates with a CHS polo.
- **Designated Dates**

The dates for tennis shoes, shorts/skirts, begin the start of school until October 15th. The second phase begins April 15th until the end of the school year. Boys may wear their polo and shorts to Mass during the designated dates. When out of the warm period, a long white sleeve dress shirt with Cabrini Tie (**freshmen**) or tie of choice (sophomores, juniors, seniors) must be worn. Dates will be announced to remind students of these requirements.

- Purses, bags, and backpacks must be left in the school locker at all times.
- Tattoos must be covered.
- No nose, eyebrow, tongue piercings, gauges, or other piercings besides earrings permitted. No bandaged nose piercings are acceptable. Nose rings/piercings must be removed.

Hair

Hairstyles must be kept neat and clean by all. Conservative hairstyles consisting of one natural color with no stark contrasting color differences are required. Uneven layers, spiked hair, partial shaving, hair with lines, designs, or gashes, or appreciable differences in levels are not permitted. Hair styles and multiple coloring that detract from the spirit of the uniform code are not allowed. Gentlemen's hair is to be kept at the collar and above the eyebrow at a reasonable height. Haircuts are to be traditional and conservative.

Facial Hair

A cleaned and trimmed mustache, above the lip, is acceptable. Sideburns must come no lower than the base of the ear. No other facial hair is permitted.

Jeans Days

Jeans must be neat, clean, fit appropriately and without holes, rips, or tears. Nylon warm up suits, sweatpants, yoga pants, or jeggings are not allowed. Students are permitted to wear Cabrini team shirts. No tank tops, halter tops, bare midriff tops, sleeveless or belly shirts are allowed. All tops must completely cover the mid-section and collarbone. No army fatigue style clothing may be worn. Shirts with alcohol or drugs statements, statements or symbols demeaning to anyone or gang related will not be permitted. Athletic shoes, properly tied, are permitted, and socks must be worn. Sandals and similar footwear are not allowed.
