At this time we would like to clarify our new tuition policy and what it means to be a registered and active parishioner at St. Frances Cabrini. Those who indicate they are parishioners of St. Frances Cabrini have to be registered and active, for at least 6 months to receive the Cabrini credit for tuition. By active, the expectation is to attend Mass on a regular basis, participate in parish events, and utilize the weekly church envelopes. The use of envelopes is the only way that we can verify your attendance at the Eucharist, the source and summit of our faith, and the very reason our schools exist. A suggested amount of weekly contribution is \$15.00, but any amount is appreciated. Your status will be verified by the tuition office on a regular basis throughout the year.

To qualify for the Cabrini tuition credit you have to be registered by August 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. After 6 months, you will receive the credit, if you have meet the guidelines listed above. If you register after August 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year you will not be eligible for the credit until the following school year. If you are already a registered Cabrini parishioner, your registration status will be monitored with the same requirements.

Those who indicate membership in another Roman Catholic Church, you will be charged the non-Catholic tuition rate until a letter is received from your parish. This letter needs to be on parish letterhead stating that you are registered and active with them. Once the letter is received in the tuition office the tuition credit will be issued to your account. A new letter is needed every year and has to be received in the tuition office by August 1<sup>st</sup>, of the current year.

If you have no affiliation with a Roman Catholic parish, you will be charged the non-Catholic rate.

To be eligible for financial aid assistance from any of our available grant resources you have to apply for the Archdiocese of Detroit Grant. The information you provide to the Archdiocese of Detroit will be utilized by our Cabrini Grant Committee to determine awards.
