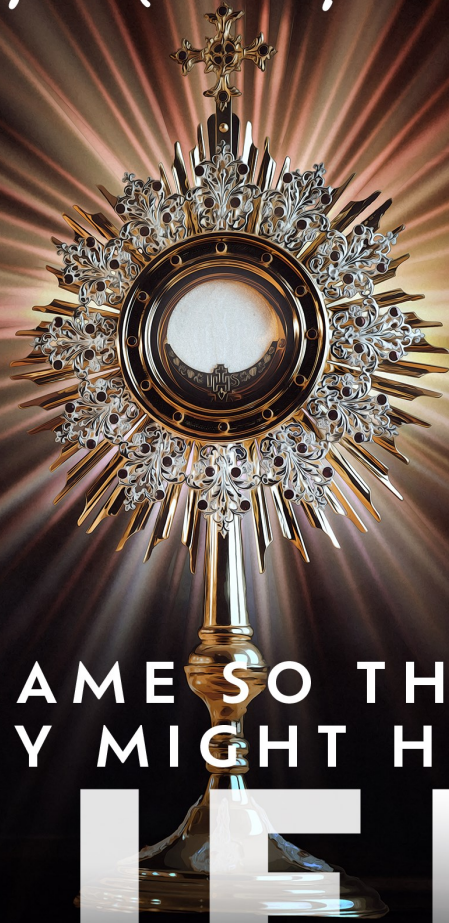

# Weekend at Birney's



## Respect Life Sunday & Month

In October, the Catholic Church in the United States celebrates *Respect Life Month*, and the first Sunday of October is designated as *Respect Life Sunday*. This month-long focus is to help Catholics understand and value the gift of human life and help build a culture that cherishes and protects it.

Throughout this month, I will share teachings/reflections about the dignity of life:

“As Catholics approach the polls, we are asked to weigh many important issues. The U.S. bishops have reaffirmed that “the threat of abortion remains our preeminent priority because it directly attacks life itself, because it takes place within the sanctuary of the family, and because of the number of lives destroyed.” While they did warn us not to “dismiss or ignore other serious threats to human life and dignity such as racism, the environmental crisis, poverty, and the death penalty,” they did give priority to upholding and defending our brothers’ and sisters’ most basic right—to live.

Abortion tragically ends someone’s life when he or she is most vulnerable and most in need of loving protection. Abortion is an intrinsic evil, meaning that it is never permitted or morally justified, regardless of individual circumstances or intentions. The personal and societal consequences of attacks against human life, whether at its earliest stages or at its final stages, are all the more serious because most often they are “carried out in the very heart of and with the complicity of the family—the family which by its nature is called to be the ‘sanctuary of life.’ This is the place where a person should be *most* loved, cherished, and protected.” – Archbishop Naumann (former Chairman of Pro-Life Committee).

### Walking With Moms

*Walking with Moms in Need* is a nationwide, parish-based initiative to increase support for pregnant and parenting mothers in need. It works to ensure that any woman who finds herself unexpectedly pregnant, or parenting in difficult circumstances, can turn to her local Catholic Church and be connected with the resources she needs. Volunteers walk with moms throughout the motherhood journey, offering them authentic Christian friendship and ongoing support. # Fin de Semana en Birney's

## Respeto a la Vida Domingo & Mes

En octubre, la Iglesia Católica en los Estados Unidos celebra el *Mes de Respeto a la Vida*, y el primer domingo de octubre se designa como el Domingo de *Respeto a la Vida*. Este enfoque de un mes es ayudar a los católicos a comprender y valorar el don de la vida humana y ayudar a construir una cultura que lo aprecie y proteja. A lo largo de este mes, compartiré enseñanzas/reflexiones sobre la dignidad de la vida:

"A medida que los católicos se acercan a las urnas, se nos pide que sopesemos muchos temas importantes. Los obispos de Estados Unidos han reafirmado que "la amenaza del aborto sigue siendo nuestra prioridad preeminente porque ataca directamente a la vida misma, porque tiene lugar dentro del santuario de la familia y por el número de vidas destruidas". Si bien nos advirtieron que no "descartemos ni ignoremos otras amenazas graves a la vida y la dignidad humanas, como el racismo, la crisis ambiental, la pobreza y la pena de muerte", sí dieron prioridad a mantener y defender el derecho más básico de nuestros hermanos y hermanas: vivir.

El aborto termina trágicamente con la vida de alguien cuando es más vulnerable y más necesitado de protección amorosa. El aborto es un mal intrínseco, lo que significa que nunca está permitido ni justificado moralmente, independientemente de las circunstancias o intenciones individuales. Las consecuencias personales y sociales de los atentados contra la vida humana, tanto en sus primeras fases como en sus etapas finales, son tanto más graves cuanto que la mayoría de las veces se llevan a cabo "en el corazón mismo de la familia y con la complicidad de ésta, la familia que, por su naturaleza, está llamada a ser el 'santuario de la vida'. Este es el lugar donde una persona debe ser *más* amada, apreciada y protegida." – Arzobispo Naumann (ex Presidente del Comité Pro-Vida).

## Caminando con las mamás

*Walking with Moms in Need* es una iniciativa parroquial a nivel nacional para aumentar el apoyo a las madres embarazadas y madres necesitadas. 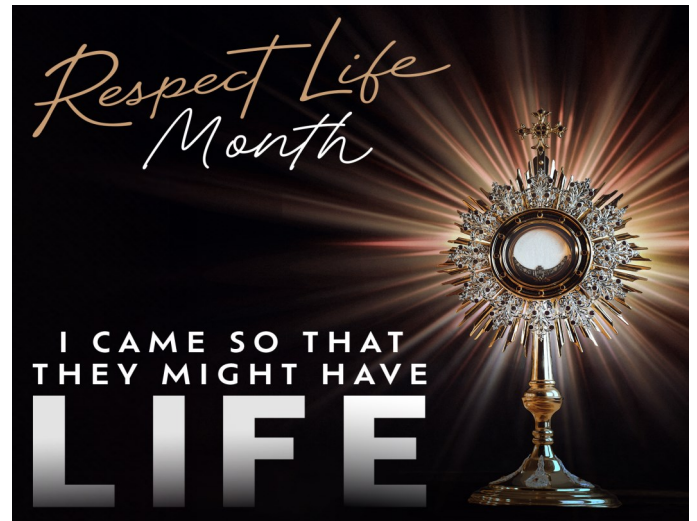

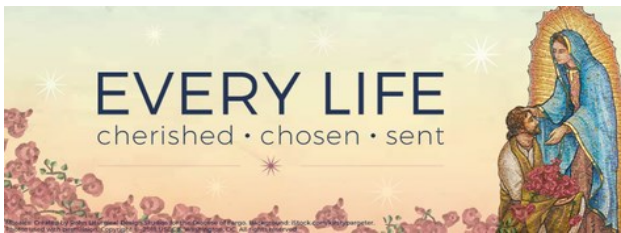

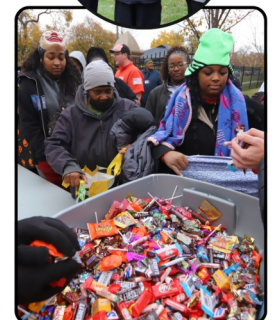
