Lift Up Your Hearts

Today is VOCATION AWARENESS SUNDAY. We begin a whole month of prayer with all the parishes in our country. The word “vocation” is used in a broad sense for any Call in Life. A commitment, a choice, responding to a “SUMMONS”.

But here, the focus is on the Call to serve the Church and respond to the need for more priests. Pope Francis spoke of the Call this way: “BECOMING A PRIEST OR A MAN OR WOMAN RELIGIOUS IS NOT PRIMARILY OUR OWN DECISION. RATHER IT IS THE RESPONSE TO A CALL AND A CALL TO SERVE AND A CALL TO LOVE.

Here is a true story about my vocation: One morning as I was serving mass at Precious Blood Church, in Detroit, I had a strong feeling. As I looked up at the priest and saw him praying the mass, I remember saying to myself: “That’s what I am going to be when I grow up.” That happened when I was about in the fifth grade. By the on-going gift of Jesus, that has never changed.

And this is true for each one of us, no matter what our CALL in life has been, or is now we all have a CALL in life. To know God’s Plan and follow it the best we can. Married, single, or single again try to take some time each day to talk to Jesus, and to LISTEN TO HIS WORD IN OUR HEARTS. “The love of God has been poured into our hearts.”

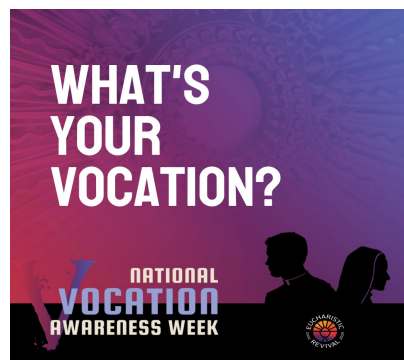
