

Weekend at Birney's



First Sunday of Lent

"The Gospel this weekend highlights for us one of the central themes of the Season of Lent. We are dependent upon God for all that we have and all that we are. Anything that leads us to reject this

dependency or to distrust its sufficiency, is a temptation from the devil.

Luke ends his report of Jesus' temptation in the desert by noting that the devil departs for a time. The implication is that the devil will return. Jesus knows that he will be tempted again in the Garden of Gethsemane. The depth of Jesus' trust in God is shown most fully when Jesus rejects the temptation to turn away from the task God has given to him. Jesus' final rebuke of the devil is his sacrifice on the Cross.

Jesus' responses to the temptations of the devil teach us how we can respond to temptation. As we start our journey through Lent, this Sunday's Gospel calls us to adopt the same confidence that Jesus had in the face of temptation: God's word alone will suffice, God's promise of protection can be trusted, and God alone is God." Frequently Asked Questions Regarding Changes to our Family of Parishes

When will these changes take place?

The changes detailed in the Shepherd's Synodal Report (office hours/mass schedule/pastoral staff) sent to all registered parishioners, will begin on Palm Sunday weekend (April 12-13) and every weekend thereafter, including Easter. If you have received the original mailing, Easter Sunday mass times are incorrect and will be corrected.

Which parish do we call if we need a priest?

If this occurs during normal business hours, you can call any parish, and it will be routed to the Mission Center Office. If this occurs after hours, every parish has an emergency line that rings at the priest residence. If not available to answer at the time of the call, a message can be left and will be answered in a timely fashion.

Are these changes only occurring at the Quo Vadis Domine Family?

No. The Archdiocese of Detroit has established the Office of Parish Renewal tasked with leading the entire Archdiocese of Detroit through a reorganization plan regarding parishes. This was outlined in the final Pastoral Note from Archbishop Vigneron entitled: No Second Tunic: A Plan for Mission-Ready Families of Parishes in the Archdiocese of Detroit. What is a "Mission-Ready Parish"?

Mission-Ready Parishes have an abundance of financial and human resources to carry out their God-given mission of saving souls. They are led by teams of priests who are healthy and thriving—spiritually, emotionally, and physically—and ready to carry out the mission for which they were ordained. These parish communities are fully alive and growing, with a clear sense of mission to form joyful disciples. They prioritize a culture that is vibrant and attracts the disaffiliated, youth, young adults and marginalized, while continuing to equip current parishioners with the joy of the Gospel. They are focused on the Apostolic work of the Church—in Word, Sacrament, and Service—over efforts to sustain aging church buildings.

Fin de Semana en Birney's

Primer Domingo de Cuaresma

"El Evangelio de este fin de semana pone de relieve para nosotros uno de los temas centrales del tiempo de Cuaresma. Dependemos de Dios por todo lo que tenemos y por todo lo que somos. Cualquier cosa que nos lleve a rechazar esta dependencia o a desconfiar de su suficiencia, es una tentación del demonio.

Lucas termina su relato de la tentación de Jesús en el desierto señalando que el diablo se va por un tiempo. La implicación es que el diablo regresará. Jesús sabe que será tentado de nuevo en el huerto de Getsemaní. La profundidad de la confianza de Jesús en Dios se muestra más plenamente cuando Jesús rechaza la tentación de apartarse de la tarea que Dios le ha encomendado. La reprimenda final de Jesús al diablo es su sacrificio en la Cruz.

Las respuestas de Jesús a las tentaciones del diablo nos enseñan cómo podemos responder a la tentación. Al comenzar nuestro camino a través de la Cuaresma, el Evangelio de este domingo nos llama a adoptar la misma confianza que Jesús tuvo frente a la tentación: solo la palabra de Dios será suficiente, se puede confiar en la promesa de protección de Dios y solo Dios es Dios". Preguntas Frecuentes Sobre los Cambios en Nuestra Familia de Parroquias

¿Cuándo se producirán estos cambios?

Los cambios detallados en el Informe Sinodal del Pastor (horario de oficina/horario de misas/personal pastoral) enviado a todos los feligreses registrados, comenzarán el fin de semana del Domingo de Ramos (12-13 de abril) y todos los fines de semana a partir de entonces, incluida la Pascua. Si ha recibido el correo original, los horarios de las misas del Domingo de Pascua son incorrectos y serán corregidos.

¿A qué parroquia llamamos si necesitamos un sacerdote?

Si esto ocurre durante el horario comercial normal, puede llamar a cualquier parroquia y se le enviará a la Oficina del Centro Misionero. Si esto ocurre fuera del horario de atención, cada parroquia tiene una línea de emergencia que suena en la residencia del sacerdote. Si no está disponible para responder en el momento de la llamada, se puede dejar un mensaje y se responderá de manera oportuna.

¿Estos cambios solo están ocurriendo en la familia Quo Vadis Domine?

No. La Arquidiócesis de Detroit ha establecido la Oficina de Renovación Parroquial encargada de guiar a toda la Arquidiócesis de Detroit a través de un plan de reorganización con respecto a las parroquias. Esto fue esbozado en la última Nota Pastoral del Arzobispo Vigneron titulada: **No Segunda Túnica: Un Plan para las Familias de las Parroquias Preparadas para la Misión en la Arquidiócesis de Detroit.** Puede leer esta breve Nota Pastoral en: cabriniparish.org.

¿Qué es una "Parroquia Preparada para la Misión"?

Las parroquias preparadas para la misión tienen una abundancia de recursos financieros y humanos para llevar a cabo la misión que Dios les ha dado de salvar almas. Están dirigidos por equipos de sacerdotes que están sanos y prósperos, espiritual, emocional y físicamente, y listos para llevar a cabo la misión para la que fueron ordenados. Estas comunidades parroquiales están plenamente vivas y en crecimiento, con un claro sentido de misión para formar discípulos alegres. Priorizan una cultura que sea vibrante y atraiga a los desafiliados, jóvenes, adultos jóvenes y marginados, mientras continúan equipando a los feligreses actuales con la alegría del Evangelio. Se centran en la obra apostólica de la Iglesia, en la Palabra, los Sacramentos y el Servicio, por encima de los esfuerzos para sostener los edificios eclesiásticos envejecidos.




